From a Black-Feminist perspective, Duah explores the relationship between body and sculpture. She is interested in concepts of fetishization and the potentials of synthetic surfaces. In her artistic practice, Duah seeks new and diverse forms of sculptural appreciation. She works multidisciplinary in media such as sculpture, performance and dress.

Duah was selected as a participant of the Artist Residency programperforcraZe International , in Kumasi (2021) and is a former scholarship holder of Schloss Balmoral fine arts program – Foundation for Culture Rheinland Pfalz (2019).
